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## Student Feedback Analysis Report (2021-22)

Feedback was collected from the students of the college on curriculum implementation, teaching-learning-evaluation, relevance of the curriculum and others. For this purpose Feedback forms was distributed among the students of all the departments. Heads of the Departments collected the forms from the students and submitted to IQAC. As many as 496 responses were received. In order to arrive at comprehensive results, useful descriptive statistical tools and symmetrical measures have been used. The findings have been shown below.

1. Students' Response on Curriculum Implementation: The College follows the CBCS State Model Syllabus developed by State Council of Higher Education, Odisha and prescribed by Berhampur University.

The above Pie-chart presents the response of the students on curriculum implementation. 37.1\% rated it as Excellent while $33.8 \%$ rated it as Very Good and $25.6 \%$ rated it as good. $2.3 \%$ students gave their ranking as average and $1.2 \%$ students said it to be poor.
2. Student's Feedback on Course Coverage: Student gave their feedback on timely and

The above Pie-Chart shows that 27.6 \% of the students rated it as excellent where as $40.8 \%$ rated it as Very Good. $23.7 \%$ of total response indicates it as good while only $5.9 \%$ rated it as average and the rest rated it as poor.
3. Student's Assessment on The Relevance of the Syllabus To The Contemporary Trends :

It is noted that only $1.1 \%$ rated it as average and $0.6 \%$ rated it as poor.

## 4. Student's Evaluation On Faculty Members Initiative For Classroom Interaction :

The above pie-chart shows the response of the students on classroom interaction. Of the total responses, $46.8 \%$ opined it to be Excellent, $32.9 \%$ rated it to be Very Good and $15.7 \%$ said it to be good. $3.8 \%$ rated it to be average and only $0.8 \%$ opined it to be poor.
5. Students' Feedback on Teachers' Illustration Skill :

The above pie-chart shows the responses of the students towards the question whether the teachers illustrated the concepts clearly through examples and applications. Of all the respondents, majority i.e. $49.3 \%$ goes with the Excellent, $35 \%$ rated it to be Very Good Whereas $12.4 \%$ rated it to be Good; the rest rated it as either average or poor.

## 6. Usage of ICT Tools By Lecturers :

Of all the respondents, $32.1 \%$ said that it was excellent while $30.3 \%$ rated it as good, $30.5 \%$ rated it as average. $14 \%$ rated it as average and $3.1 \%$ rated it as poor.
7. Teachers' ability to communicate the course objective and course outcome:


The above pie-chart shows the response of the students toward the question whether teachers were able to communicate the course objective and course outcome. $35 \%$ of the respondents were of the opinion that teachers did an excellent job by communicating properly the course outcome and course objective. $34.3 \%$ rated it as very good, $23.6 \%$ rated it as good, and $5.1 \%$ rated it as average. Only a negligible number of students rated it as poor.
8. Fair practices used in the internal evaluation:


The above pie-chart shows the responses of the students toward the question of fairness adopted by the teachers in internal evaluation process. Out of all the respondents, $40.2 \%$ rated it as Excellent, $32.4 \%$ rated it as Very Good, $20.3 \%$ rated it as good while only $6.3 . \%$ rated it as average and a very negligible number rated as poor.

## 9. Awareness of various student support systems:

The above pie-chart shows the responses of the students toward the awareness among the students of various student support systems such as scholarships, Grievance Redressal Cell, Anti-Ragging Cell, Career Counselling Cell and others. Out of all the respondents, $27.7 \%$ rated it as Excellent, $33.2 \%$ rated it as Very Good, $33.1 \%$ rated it as good while only $3.7 \%$ rated it as average and only $3.3 \%$ rated it as poor.
10. Institution's initiative in promoting internship, student exchange, project work and field visit.

The above pie-chart shows the responses of the students towards their satisfaction regarding the institution's initiative for promotion of internship, student exchange, project work, field visit etc. The response from $30.3 \%$ students was Excellent, $30.6 \%$ said it was very good, $27.1 \%$ gave the rating to be good where as $9.4 \%$ rated it to be average. Only $2.6 \%$ rated it as poor.
